

Accordion Paper Snake

An at home, fun reptile themed, craft activity for Ages 7-12 (can be modified for younger or older children). Provided by Gumbo Limbo education staff.

Parental Supervision may be needed

1. Gather your materials: You will need 2 different construction paper colors, googly eyes, scissors, glue, and a black marker.
2. Prepare your materials: Cut the colored construction paper into even 2 inch strips. Cut a head (oval shape) and tongue (forked shape) for your snake.
3. Glue strips together at the very end of the paper.



4. Fold the paper over in an accordion fashion and glue.



5. Continue this accordion style folding until you have used all of the strip. (To make a longer snake, glue on additional strip to the end)



6. Once you are finished folding your snake body, glue on the head to the last fold. Decorate with the googly eyes and black marker.
7. Pull, stretch, and wiggle your snake!
8. Your child now has an awesome snake craft!
