

Paper Plate Shark Craft

An at home, fun shark themed, craft activity for Ages 3-6 (can be modified for younger or older children). Provided by Gumbo Limbo education staff.

Parental Supervision may be needed

1. Gather your materials: You will need a paper plate, gray paint, googly eyes, construction paper, scissors, and glue.
2. To create the body of your shark, cut out a triangular piece, creating a pac-man like shape.
3. Paint the majority of the paper plate gray, leaving the bottom 1/4th white. Let dry.
4. While your body is drying, take the construction paper and cut out a tail and a smaller bottom fin. You can use the large triangle that you cut out before as your top dorsal fin. Paint these pieces gray to match the body. Don't forget to cut out teeth!
5. Attach the fins and tail to the body. Glue googly eyes on head, and glue on the teeth to its mouth!
6. Your child now has a cute paper plate shark craft!
