

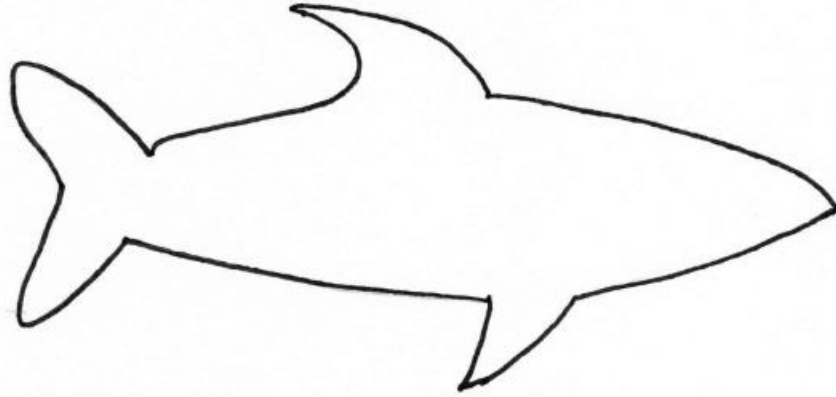
## Shark Sun Catcher

An at home, fun shark themed, craft activity for Ages 3-12 (can be modified for younger or older children). Provided by Gumbo Limbo education staff.

\*Parental Supervision/Assistance may be needed\*

1. Gather your materials: You will need clear contact paper (or plastic wrap), construction paper, different colors of tissue paper, glue, the shark master template, a pencil, scissors.
2. Prepare your materials: Trace the sharks onto a piece of construction paper – cut out. Take tissue paper and cut them into various shapes.
3. Take clear contact paper (or plastic wrap) and cut 2 identical pieces into any shape.
4. Glue pieces of the tissue paper to create a mosaic design on one piece of the contact paper/plastic wrap – let dry.
5. Once you have created your background design, take the shark pieces and glue them on top of the tissue paper – let dry.
6. Take the other piece of contact paper/plastic wrap and glue/stick it on top of the shark pieces, sandwiching the contact paper/plastic wrap together with the tissue paper and shark pieces in the middle.
7. Your child now has a colorful sun catcher craft!
