

# Vulture Origami!

Follow these steps to make your own scavenger craft!

- It's recommended to use thinner and colored paper!
- Try gray origami paper to make a **black vulture**!



1. Start with a square piece of paper.

2. Fold it in half diagonally both ways, then unfold.



3. Flip it over, and fold it in half both ways.

4. Fold it into a square.



5. Take one of the edges, and fold it inside itself.

6. Take the top flap and bottom flap and fold them up.

7. Fold the piece so the inner creases are now on the outside.



8. Take one of the two upper points and fold it over, then fold part of it back over.

9. Repeat this for the other side, then fold the top flap up over them.



10. Fold the piece in half, with the open part on the outside.

11. Fold the tips of the tips sticking out to make the feet.



12. Do the same thing to the point closest to the feet to make the tail.

13. Fold the other point down towards the feet so the outside makes a near 90 degree angle.

14. Fold the tip of this down, then fold the tip of that down again to make the beak.



15. Congratulations! You've made a vulture!



The **black vulture** is a scavenger that lives throughout tropical and subtropical Americas
